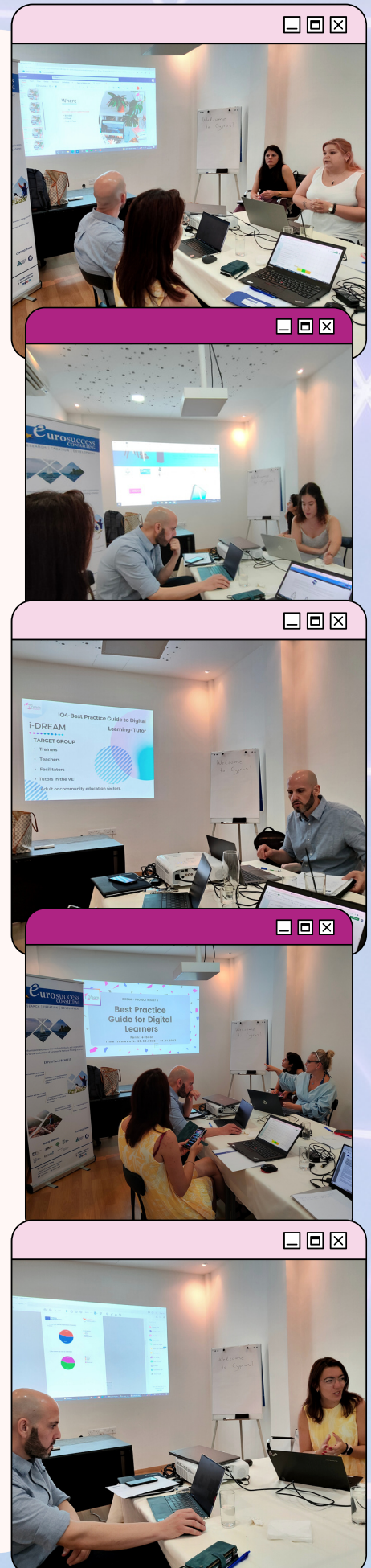


INTELLECTUAL OUTPUTS

In the project we will develop 5 intellectual outputs. The first one - Common Profile of the Digital Tutor - is ready. Its final version was made a few months ago.

The second result – Common Curricula & Modular Content for Digital Teachers/ Trainers/ Researchers/ Youth workers – is under evaluation and improvement. Soon we will present its final version on our e-platform (IO3 - online eTOOL for Educators, Teachers/ Trainers/ Researchers /Youth workers). During the meeting, we saw a draft of the platform. We discussed in detail its appearance, functions and facilities for users.

We also worked together on the development of the two more intellectual outputs– IO4 (Best Practice Guide for Digital Teachers) and IO5 (Best Practice Guide for Digital Learners). The partners shared their thoughts and ideas in the presentations. We agreed that both results are cohesive.

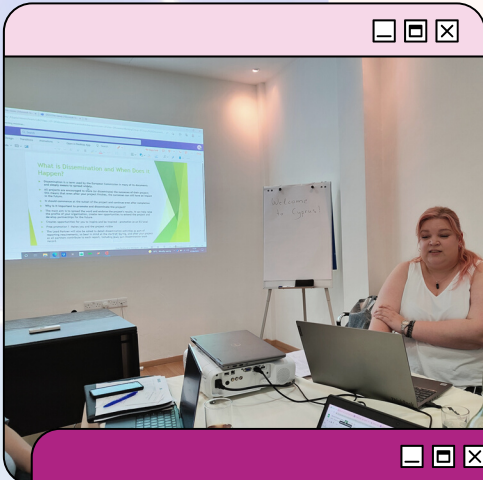


MANAGEMENT AND DISSEMINATION

Direct project meetings always offer a great opportunity to make the project progress more effective. We are grateful to all participants for an intense and fruitful time.



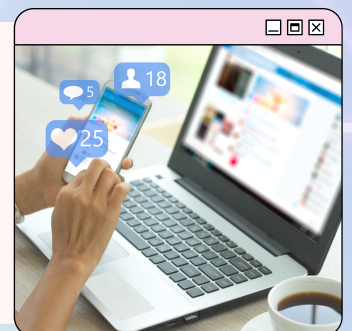
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
