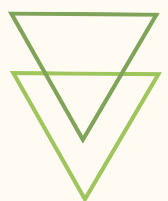
These are an extensive pedagogical guidelines (methodology) to follow while working with seniors and youth.

- What is the aim of this resource?

It is known that seniors require external motivation and incentives to go into a new-tech world. Besides, they require a lot of movement and design-thinking activities to stay active for a long time. They also desire to reject the feeling of lack of purpose, especially burdensome when they retire, while still willing to be active and contribute to society.

Benefiting from this work package, adult educators and facilitators will be able to overcome these obstacles. Digital skills, supported by educators, will provide seniors with the necessary skills to address digital transformation issues particularly in the post Covid-19 period.

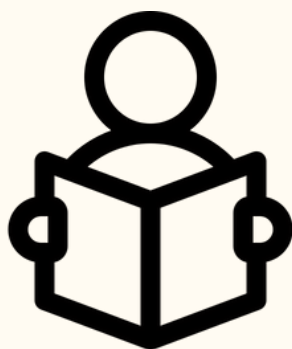


SOME OF THE KEY TOPICS COVERED IN THIS COURSE WILL INCLUDE:
